



WHAT DREW YOU TO WRITING ON SCIMITARS AND SCALPELS?


History is a passion of mine, in particular the Crusades, and healthcare my profession. They say to write about what you know, so that is how the warrior physician notion set during the Crusades came about

The principal characters were, to me, straightforward "stock in trade" type heroes except for the physician/warrior hybrid aspect which is unusual and, I hope, gives the novel some original appeal to readers.

It was the peripheral characters I had the best fun dreaming up – the tormented Fr Benedict, the mad mystic Abubakhar, Usama ibn Munqidh, the squeamish Kali, the larger-than-life Queen Naiki Devi.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR YOUR FUTURE BOOK/S?
