

A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR WHO DID YOU WRITE A SILENCE IN THE FOREST FOR AND WHY?

I wrote A Silence in the Forest for my niece who was five or six at the time. My original plan was to write one book for my niece and another for my nephew. When I had that idea the character of the fairy for my niece fell into place and I have plans for the book for my nephew with a bird as the main character.

WHAT KIND OF RESEARCH GOES INTO WRITING YOUR BOOKS?

It depends what I am writing about but it can be days or even weeks of research! Children's books usually come entirely from my imagination, though I've recently written a book about a black cockatoo. In writing this I had to research what they eat, their habitat, behavioural patterns, tricks they can perform, etc. so that these facts could be incorporated into the book.
