# Letting go



Physically able to keep him at arm's length, yet psychologically, he is all she can think about, dream about, desire...



# A Conversation with Katrina

## **Why did you write this book?**

*I wrote based of an idea. The idea that attraction can be evident, though genders have different ideas about that attraction and the whole love concept.*

## **How did you decide on the characters in the book?**
