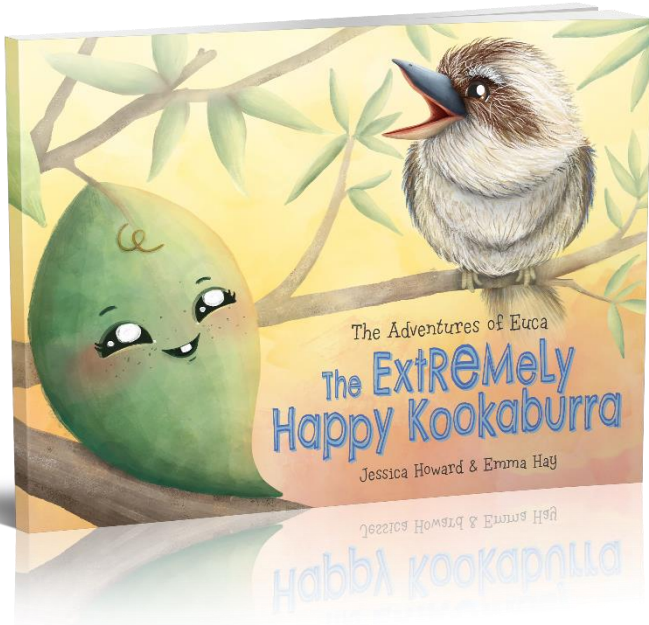

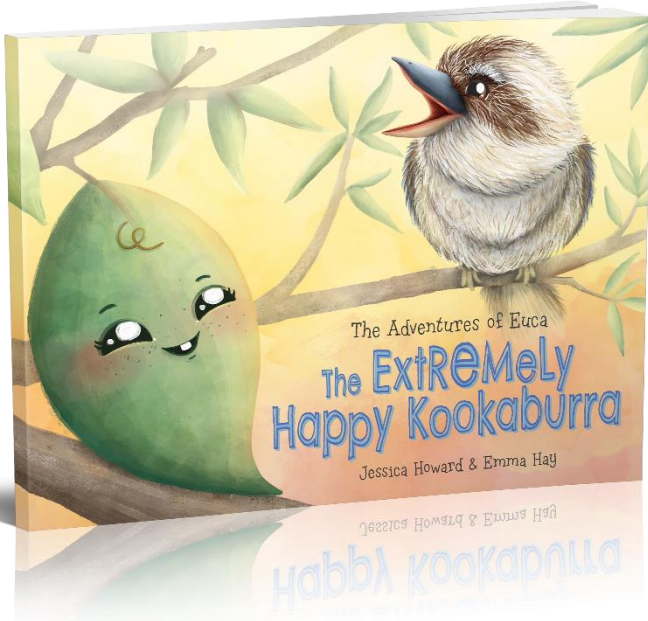

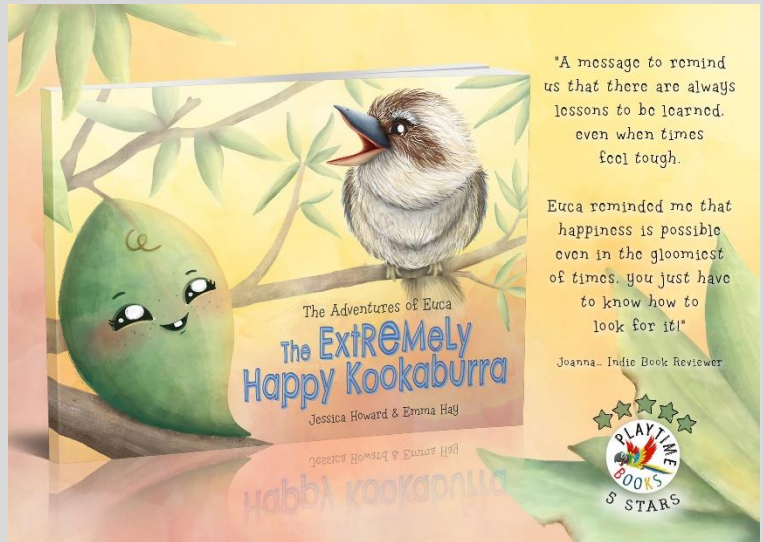
A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHY DID YOU WRITE *THE ADVENTURES OF EUCA*? WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

I enjoy creating books for kids because it is a platform to educate them on important issues, whilst still creating a lovely, fun story.

WHAT IS YOUR WRITING PROCESS LIKE?

I find my ideas come to me when I'm spending time in nature, enjoying the beauty and recharging. From there I find it easiest to just let the story flow without thinking about it too much. Once the story is on paper then I can go back and do lots and lots of editing and drafts to get to the final product. This can take a few months to get that final draft which flows well and also tells the story!
