




J. A. Fuller is an aspiring author from Melbourne, Australia, debuting her very first romantic fantasy novel, Ice Heart.

A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

HOW DID YOU COME UP WITH THE TITLE?

Ice Heart was a title that came from the novel's very early beginnings when I was around 13 years old.
