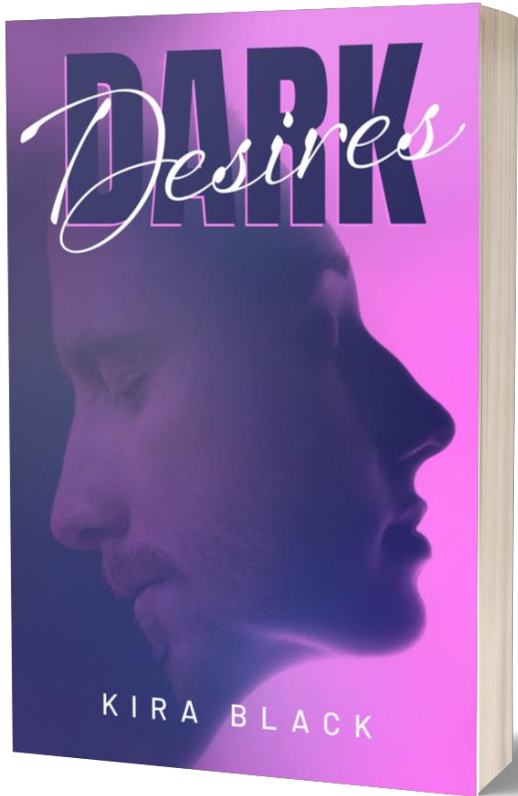


Dark Desires

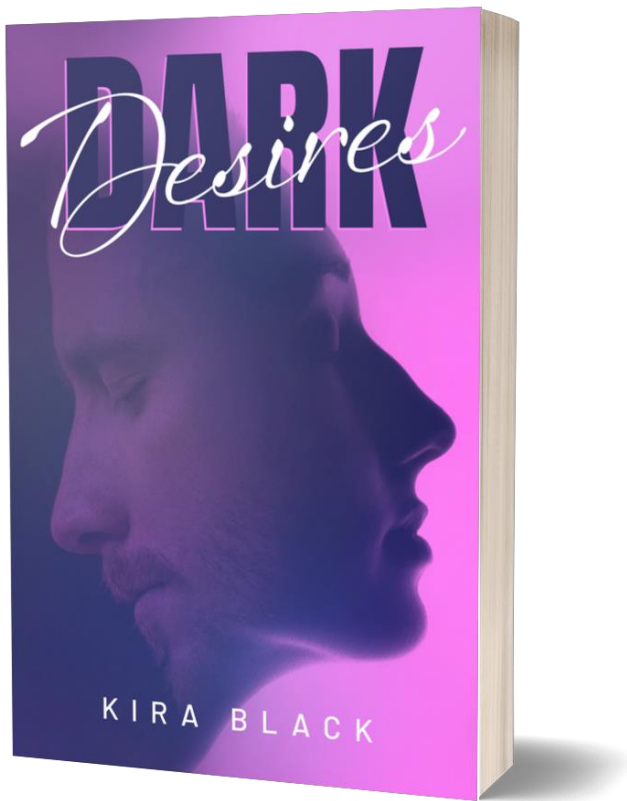

HOW LONG DO YOU SPEND RESEARCHING BEFORE BEGINNING A BOOK?

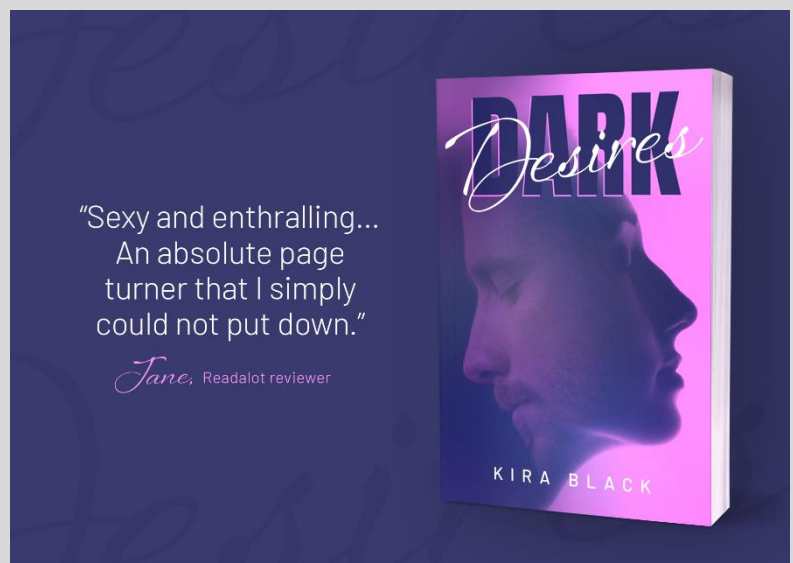
I tend to write first and research after. I only tend to research what I have to.
