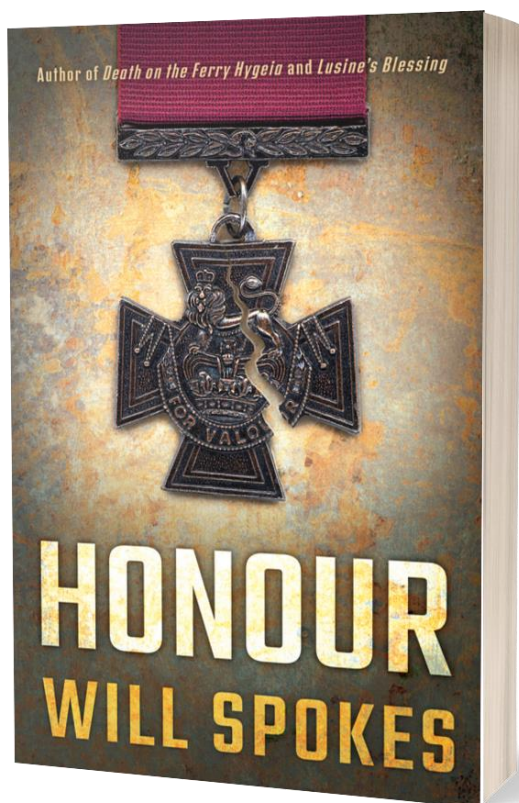

## A HERO DISGRACED; A REPUTATION FRACTURED...

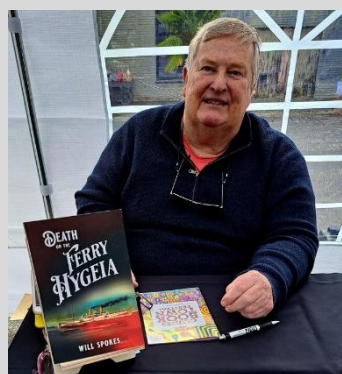
Early settlers at opposite ends of the continent strive in the face of overwhelming environmental odds, battling everything the urgencies of a fledgling nation can throw at them.

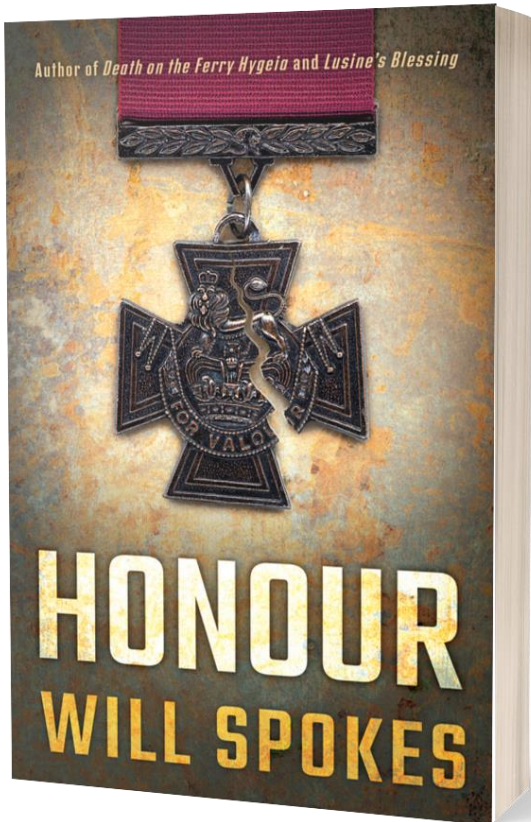

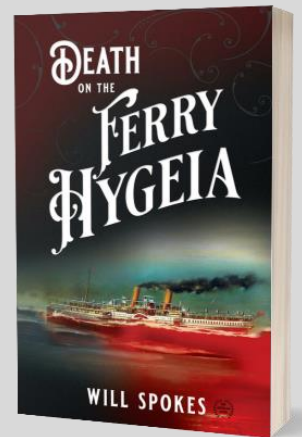

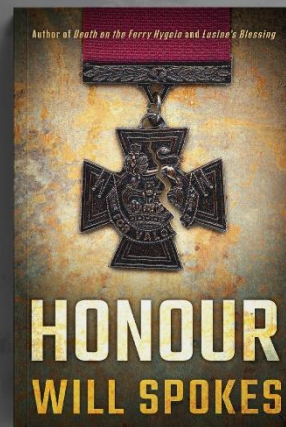
