A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR WHY DID YOU WRITE *ZIFFING?* WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

For decades I have taken my kids and grandkids skiing and snowboarding, and we have always loved the snowfields environment. Wherever I go with grandkids, whether it is on the coast or in the mountains, I try to encourage the creation of a story. This book started with the idea for a short story about a bank robbery at a ski resort. However, as the characters developed, I left the kids behind and the original short story for young ages developed into a YA novel.

HOW DID YOU COME UP WITH YOUR TITLE?

I wanted a word that encapsulated the thrill of skiing fast, then how that activity – handling bumps, ruts, obstacles, and falls – can be a metaphor for life. The word is my own creation; I wanted an onomatopoeic title - the sound of skis moving fast over snow. The main character lends the word to the desire to be 'Ziffing' through life.

WHEN DID YOU FIRST REALISE YOU WANTED TO WRITE?

I wrote from early childhood; I created stories and poems for my family and neighbours and contributed to school 'Newspapers'. Apart from a short stint in Journalism, I neglected my true calling, pursuing financial security and raising a family.
