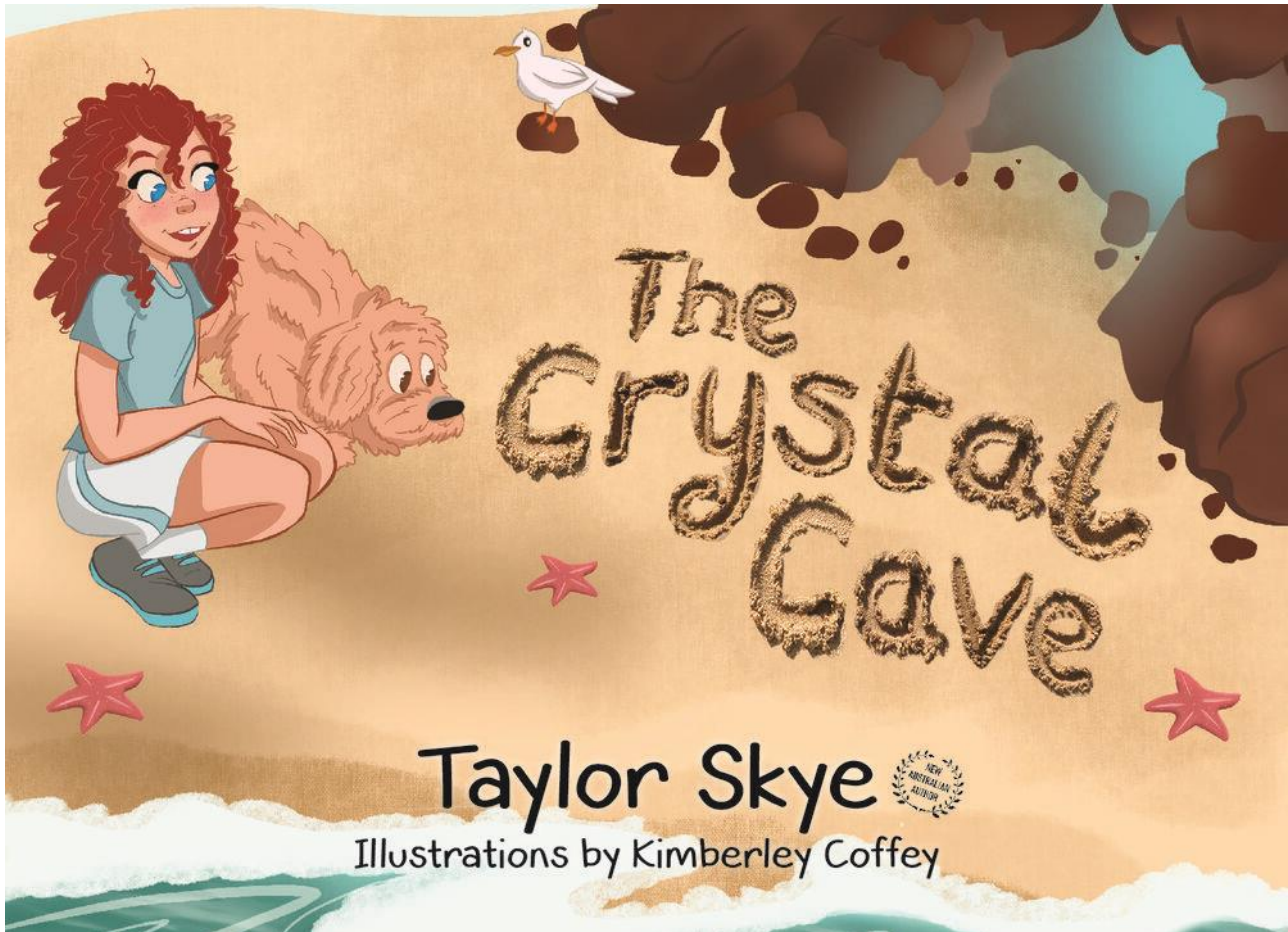

Taylor is a young enthusiastic first-time writer.

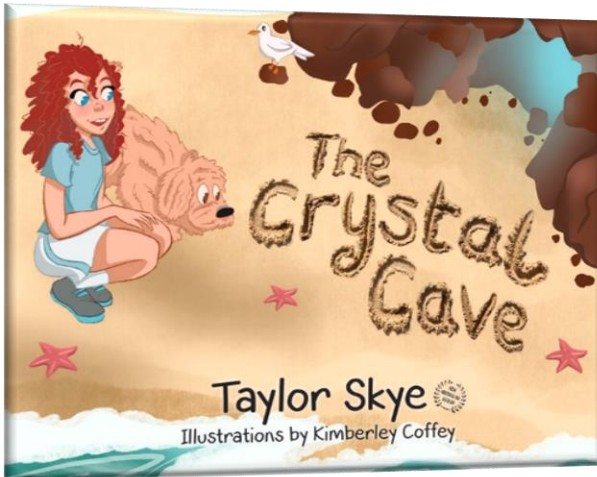
She draws inspiration from her love of animals, the power of crystals and all things magical.
