



A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHY DID YOU WRITE 'TEST OF WILLS'? WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

We used to holiday at Mulwala in a caravan park. Mum and Dad had a caravan in the same park. One rainy night myself (armed with a bottle of red wine) and my daughter Annie went to their caravan and Dad told us some stories of his life in the Hitler Youth camps. As we left that night Annie said to me, 'Why do I need to learn history at school when I can just listen to Pop.' From that moment on I was hooked.

I bought a tape recorder and Dad shared all his stories and memories from childhood of his life in Germany during World War Two and life post war. The more he told me, the more intrigued I became. His stories of courage and bravery astounded me. The more he told me the more I wanted to know. It was not only his stories, but I read other people's experiences from the same time. It became important for me to know as much as I could about his life so I could document it for the rest of my family, especially the grandchildren.

I am also a passionate believer in teaching children important events and times in history. I realised I could use his adventures to weave a fictional story full of fun and adventure with some cheeky mischief to help children understand life for young boys during World War Two.

HOW DO YOU CREATE OR MODEL YOUR CHARACTERS TO FIT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STORY AND THE EXPECTATIONS OF THE READERS?

My story is aimed at children from the ages of ten to thirteen years of age and so I needed the characters to be cheeky, mischievous and not scared to have a sense of adventure. I really wanted them to know the difference between right and wrong. They needed to be believable as it was important for the reader to develop a relationship with the main characters, to feel their fear, vulnerability and courage.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR YOUR FUTURE BOOKS?

I love writing for children. I have another historical fiction story called 'Stumped' aimed at Year 3 students. It's about two boys going back in time through a virtual reality site on their computer to the gold rush era in Victoria. They are taken hostage by some bushrangers to become the decoys that will be thrown in front of a stagecoach as the coach is robbed of its gold.
