



A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHY DID YOU WRITE 'ASTRID'S BIG DAY'? WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

I read an article in the Ballarat Courier about a high school student who had just published her book "Splish Splash Splosh" and decided to give it a go. I thought about different topics for a while and settled on this one after noticing the wide range of emotions my dog has during a day.


I modelled the story around my dog and the concept of recognising emotions. I also chose my dog Astrid because she is so much more expressive than my other dog Starsky.

WHAT DREW YOU TO THE SUBJECT MATTER OF 'ASTRID'S BIG DAY'?

I was at the park with my dogs and Astrid was having the time of her life chasing the ball, playing with other dogs, and rolling in mud. As soon as we got home and she heard the bath running she had a look of sheer terror on her face, then after the bath she was calm. This range of emotions in such a short period of time was my inspiration.

WHAT WAS AN EARLY EXPERIENCE WHERE YOU LEARNED THAT LANGUAGE HAD POWER?
