



A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHY DID YOU WRITE THIS BOOK SERIES, 'AN ECHO OF THE ASHES'? WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

It was all pretty random. A line came into my head, and to this day I don't know why. Once I wrote that line down the story came with it. I have always been drawn to history, mythology, and fantasy so this created an outlet for my ideas. Worldbuilding is a passion of mine so once I had written that single line, I devoted a year to building a world. Both in novels and film I have always found it difficult to get immersed into things that don't seem like they should be logically possible. I prefer a more grounded approach. With this series and world, I wanted to create a fantasy story that was as real as it gets. A world with a rich lore and deep characters. A world in which there is no 'good' and 'evil'. A world where the characters are not black and white, but morally grey. They have their own loves and hates, passions and demons. I have always been interested in the power of symbols, both religious and physical, and this story enabled me to create my own.

HOW HAD YOU DECIDED ON THE BEST CHARACTERS FOR THE BOOK?

They just came naturally to me. The first scene that I thought of doesn't actually happen until book two, and it features Kitara. She was my very first character. The story started to construct itself around her. Astrid came next, followed by Lukas of Annora. As these characters became more and more fleshed out, the story developed. Kyler appeared next, followed by Cailean and Sakkar.

WHAT ARE YOUR PLANS FOR YOUR FUTURE BOOKS?

Once all three books from An Echo of the Ashes are complete, I plan to write a standalone prequel, and then a sequel series. I already have a lot of ideas jotted down.
