




A CONVERSATION WITH THE AUTHOR

WHY DID YOU WRITE 'PORTRAIT OF A PRINCESS'? WHAT WERE YOUR INSPIRATIONS?

I wrote the first chapter more than 5 years ago. My youngest sister, along with my parents, had moved interstate to a farm in rural New South Wales, and I missed them desperately. Initially intended as just a short story for my eyes only, to remind me that they are in a beautiful place and are happy together, it sat for a long time, unread. I showed it to my fiancée one day, who was brought to tears, saying how beautiful my words were.

DO YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS TO HELP OTHERS BECOME A BETTER WRITER? IF SO, WHAT ARE THEY?

Write for yourself. The only way you are going to get your idea out in a satisfying way, is if you write what you want to write first and get opinions later. There was more than one occasion during the process of my writing, where someone would read something over my shoulder and explain why they didn't think it worked. Once I had completed my story and they read the whole thing, it presented itself in a more complete way, changing their perspective on the part they had seen and its relevance to the overall story. Had I listened to their critiques while I was in the process of writing, my story might not have ended up the way it is now.
